# SONIC HEROES™ INSTALLATION

## AUTORUN:

1. Turn the computer on and start Windows 98SE/Me/2000/XP. Please close any other programs that you have running.
2. Place the SONIC HEROES Disc 1 in the CD-ROM drive and wait 30 seconds. The Install launcher should appear.
3. Select Install the game and follow the on-screen instructions.

**NOTE:** If the Autorun feature is disabled or does not work properly, please follow one of the manual installation methods below.

## MANUAL INSTALLATION METHOD ONE:

1. Turn the computer on and start Windows 98SE/Me/2000/XP. Please close any other programs that you have running.
2. Place the SONIC HEROES Disc 1 in the CD-ROM drive.
3. Click on [Start] and then click on [Run].
4. Type the letter of your CD-ROM drive (usually "D") followed by a colon (:) and the word "autorun". Then click on the [OK] button. (Example: "D:autorun")
5. The Install launcher should appear. Select Install the game and follow the on-screen instructions.

## MANUAL INSTALLATION METHOD TWO:

1. Turn the computer on and start Windows 98SE/Me/2000/XP. Please close any other programs that you have running.
2. Place the SONIC HEROES Disc 1 in the CD-ROM drive.
3. Double-click on the [My Computer] icon from your desktop.
4. Double-click on the CD-ROM icon labeled [SONIC HEROES].
5. The Install launcher should appear. Select Install the game and follow the on-screen instructions.

## GETTING STARTED AFTER INSTALLATION:

1. Place the SONIC HEROES Disc 2 in the CD-ROM drive.
2. Click on [Start] and then select [Programs].
3. Select Sega, SONIC HEROES, SONIC HEROES to start the game.

## SETTING UP OPTIONS

Select Options on the Play launcher to bring up the option setup screen. This is where you set up sound, screen mode, mouse operations and controller buttons. Set each appropriately for your PC environment.

### Sound Setting

**3D Sound:** Switch 3D sound ON or OFF.

**SE/VOICE:** Switch Sound Effects and Voice ON or OFF, and adjust the volume setting.

**BGM:** Switch Background Music ON or OFF, and adjust the volume setting.

### Screen Setting

**Screen Size:** Set the screen size and resolution here. You can select from "Full Screen" and "Window Mode".

**Fog:** Set the fog effect size here. This provides fog effects that provide a better sensation/perspective of 3D.

**Anisotropic Filter:** Turn anisotropic filter ON or OFF, which prevents textures from blurring.

**Shadow Setting:** Turn Shadow ON or OFF. When turned OFF, shadows will only be represented as dark circles.

**Free Camera:** Turn Free Camera ON or OFF. On keeps the camera positioned behind the player character and can be controlled manually.

**Clipping:** Set the clipping distance here.

**Frame Rate:** Set the screen frame rate here.

### Mouse Setting

**Mouse Setting:** Set the mouse operation here.

**Type of Moves:** The type of the movement is chosen here.

### Controller Setting

**Player:** Adjust button assignments for 1P or 2P's controller.

**Controller Setting:** Set custom button assignments.

## GAME MODES

**1P PLAY STORY:** Play the game to reveal the story.

**CHALLENGE:** Replay Missions in previously cleared Stages.

**TUTORIAL:** Tutorial that teaches the Basic Controls.

**2P PLAY:** In this mode, 2 Players each control a team battling for the highest score in accordance with the Mission objectives.

**EXTRA:** Replay music, sound effects and movies found in this game by selecting either Audio Room or CG Theatre.

**OPTIONS:** Make various changes to game settings.

**EXIT:** Quit the game.
