#### PARENTAL CONTROL

You can set up the PS Vita system to prevent access to games which may not be suitable for the age of a child using the PS Vita system. You should set the parental controls if you have a child who will be using the PS Vita system who is not old enough to play this or other games you have purchased for the PS Vita system. The age rating for this product appears on the packaging.

The default parental control level on the PS Vita system is 9. You will need to set the parental control level on the PS Vita system to one of 11 levels to prevent your child from accessing content which is not suitable for their age. The relationship between the age rating of a product in your region and the parental control levels on the PS Vita system is as follows:

For example, if your child is 11 years old, you should prevent access to content which is rated as suitable for 12 years and older. In this instance, set the parental control on the PS Vita system to level 3. The lower you set the control, the more restrictive the setting. You can always change the parental control setting to allow play by older users.

In rare cases, the parental control level for this product may be more restrictive (lower) than the level which would normally apply to the age rating in your country. This is due to differences in the age rating systems in the various countries in which this product is sold. # CONTROLS

The default controls are as follows:

Accelerate	Press the R button to accelerate.		
Drift/Brake	Press the button to brake or drift.		
Steer	Use the left stick to steer left and right.		
Rear View	Press the  button to switch to rear view.		
Use Pickup	Press the button to use a Pickup, if you had one in stock.		
Stunt	Push the right stick to perform a Stunt in the direction it is pushed.

# **PICKUPS**

There are two kinds of Pickup items found around each track: Normal and Super. Normal Pickups are identified by a question mark, and give you a random item. Super Pickups are identified by an exclamation mark, and will give you a fixed high-power item depending on its location. Only one Pickup item can be carried in stock. A different item cannot be picked up until the stocked item has been used. However a super pickup will supersede the existing weapon.



#### **Hot Rod**

Gives you a boost of speed, and pressing the Use Pickup button a second time causes an explosion that'll slow down nearby opponents. Watch the gauge on its back carefully though—leave it too late and it'll blow up in your face.



#### **Snow Cannon**

Fire 3 snowballs at opponents to slow them down. Hit the same opponent with all 3 to freeze them solid.



#### Twister

Homes in on an opponent and spins them out of control.



#### Drone

A remote controlled counterpart to your own vehicle with a stick of dynamite strapped to it. Locks onto an opponent and BOOM!



**Blow Fish** 

Drop a blow fish on the track, which will blow up when hit.



#### Glove

Shields you from projectiles for a limited time. Gloves can even catch the weapon for your own use.



#### Swarm

Send a swarm of disgruntled bees after the player furthest in front to block their progress.



### Boost

Exactly what it says on the tin. A quick boost of speed that's handy for catching up with opponents.



#### Firework

A single shot weapon that bounces off walls.

**TIP!** Certain weapon items can be fired at rivals behind you by holding the left stick down and pressing the use Pickup button.
